Born in Melbourne in 1952, Paul Boston graduated from art school in 1972. Following his studies, he travelled extensively through South-East Asia, developing an abiding interest in Zen Philosophy. Since this time he has developed an impressive exhibiting history, holding regular solo shows throughout Australia and participating in group shows in Australia and overseas. He is the recipient of a number of prizes and his work is included in the collections of all major Australian public galleries and a number of important private and corporate collections overseas. Boston currently lives and works in Melbourne.
